*For Implementation Season 2015-16 & 2016-17*

Clubs are ranked in order of the highest score with the following points allocated:- Score: 1 <sup>st</sup> = 14; 2 <sup>nd</sup> = 13; 3 <sup>rd</sup> = 12; 4 <sup>th</sup> = 11.. etc; then multiplied by the weighting = weighted score.

There is no weighting for this Event, rather a straight score is given.

### Handicap Calculations

Clubs point score divided by the number of competitors to achieve the placing which is multiplied by the weighting.
