SLST will be coordinating two Level 1 Officials Certificate Courses to take place back-to-back on Saturday 26th November 2016 at Penguin SLSC and Sunday 27th November 2016 at Carlton Park SLSC. The purpose of the weekend will be to reach members in both the south and north of the state in the hope to create a network of accredited Officials to support surf sports in 2016/17 and beyond. The course provides candidates with the knowledge and skills to effectively fulfill entry level officiating roles.

SLSA Level 1 Official Certificate – 1 day course

Sunday 27th November 2016 at Carlton Park SLSC

Time: 9am start, both full days (Exact schedule for the day TBC)

Target Audience: Aspiring, New and Lapsed Officials (Junior and Senior Sport)

Participant prerequisites: Participants must be 16+ years of age at the date of accreditation
Be a current financial member of an SLSC

Accreditation components

1. Attend a SLSA Level 1 Official Certificate – 1-day course
2. Successful completion of Participant Workbook (supplied at the course)
3. Complete Practical Assessment to be deemed competent to fulfill entry level officiating roles

Cost

To kick-start the implementation of the new Officials Network this opportunity **fully subsidised** by Surf Life Saving Tasmania and the participant will incur no cost. This course is already heavily subsidised by SLST and its true cost is over \$200 per person. All resources and meals and refreshments will be provided. An individual/ club may only incur a cost if assessment materials are failed to be returned by the due date, therefore the subsidy is unable to be applied. In this case, members will be charged the fee indicated in the current SLST Cost and Fee Schedule.
