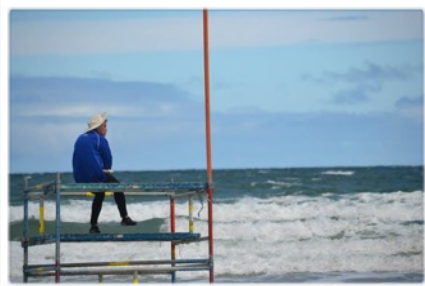

Aims

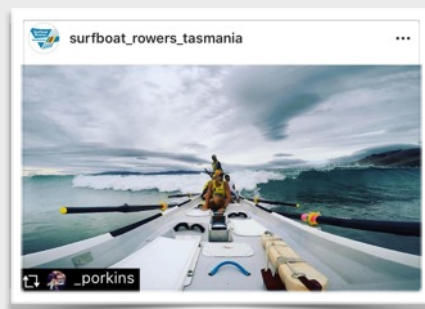
- To develop a clear model of what represents the key surf sports in Tasmania
