## Tasmanian Surf League Round 2 @ Clifton Beach SLSC Senior State-wide Carnival Bulletin

Thank you to all those who provided feedback following Round 1 at Burnie via the Survey. Several adjustments have been made for round 2 at Clifton as a result of this information:

- A few adjustments have been made to the program as a result of feedback from round 1.
- Some events will be run concurrently with staggered starts to keep the carnival moving.
- The ski leg will be retained in the U15/U17 Cameron Relay at this stage. The reason for including this is to stimulate development in ski paddling skills in readiness for transition to under 19. Clubs without an under 17 ski paddlers are encouraged to recruit from other clubs which have surplus.
- Multiple races have been included to increase opportunities for competitors to improve race skills and fitness and to simulate competition in interstate carnivals.

<b>Officials:</b>	<p>Those clubs that have competitors participating in this year's events <b>MUST</b> supply a minimum of ONE Level 1 Surf Sports Official and then additional Officials (Junior Official accredited and above) for every TEN (or part there) Competitors. The 1:10 ratio ensures adequate Officials are available to allow the event program to run to time and for multiple areas to be set up.</p> <p>To find out more about how to become an Official (Junior, Level 1 or above) please speak to Julie Kay (SLST Officials Coordinator, member of Clifton Beach).</p>

<b>Registrations:</b>	<p>All clubs are required to enter their competitors online using the Sports Event Management System (SEMS) - Normal entries close 5pm on Wednesday 02/01/2019 and late entries must be received by <b>8am on the day of the carnival, Saturday 5<sup>th</sup> January 2018</b>. Please note, Clubs when doing Carnival entries, will be required to enter competitors in individual events. If you have any questions regarding this, please direct them to Toby Whitton (VSO) or ask Liz Eustace (Carnival Recorder) to talk you through how to do this at the Carnival.
