Surf Life Saving Junior State Championships Carnival Bulletin

Date: Saturday 2nd March and Sunday 3th March 2019
Venue: Burnie SLSC

Registrations: All clubs are required to enter their competitors online using the Sports Event Management System (SEMS) by 12 midnight on Sunday 24th February 2019. Late entries will need to be submitted on paper at the carnival until 8am on the day, however an additional fee of \$11.50 will apply (per individual competitor entry). Please note, Clubs when doing Carnival entries, you will be required to enter competitors in individual and team events. Junior Preliminary Skills, Competition Skills & Surf Education Awards:

By now all Junior Activities Preliminary Skills, Competitions Skills and Surf Education Awards for all age groups should have been completed. **Clubs who have not completed their Surf Education Awards will not be able to use the Sports Event Management System to enter members who are still showing on SurfGuard as not proficient.**

Note: The board events are the only events that have been programmed to have heats and finals on separate days. All competitors must Marshall at this time and if no heats are required for a particular age group then only competitors who marshalled will start in the final. All other events will have heats (if required) followed by finals. Referees will endeavor to allow a fair rest for competitors in the final.

Supplementary regulations:

Approved sanctioned events outside of the regulations of the Surf Sports Manual 35th Revised Edition to be run at this event, include:

- There has been a request to conduct a team event in conjunction with the individual 1km run. This will be run to encourage participation in the 1km event. Teams will consist of 3 members and results will be determined on the same basis as a surf teams event. That is 1 point for 1st competitor, 2 points for 2nd, 3 points for 3rd etc. The team with the aggregate lowest points for the 3 team members will be the first team. **No medals will be awarded for this event.**
- U10 Iron Person will be run if time permits. **No medals will be awarded for this event.**

Other important event information:

- Medals will be awarded throughout the day and a final presentation and announcement is scheduled to take place 1 hour after the final event, please note: **no medals will be awarded in the U8 and U9 age groups.**
- Weather Conditions – Please note any events not started on Saturday due to weather conditions or time constraints will be held on Sunday.
- Perpetual Trophies will be awarded at the conclusion of the event, the following trophies will be presented;
 - All Age Relay (U8-U14)(No individual Medals will be awarded for this event)
 - Surf Life Saving Tasmania Junior Championships - Point Score Winner
 - Surf Life Saving Tasmania Junior Championships - Handicap Point Score Winner
- Rules for a race – Please refer Section 2 of the SLSA Surf Sports Manual (35th Revised Edition), General Competition Conditions, for full details of age specific rulings.
- The combining of competitors into event categories may be permitted in the case of insufficient competitors, or for other reasons to aid the conduct of the competition. The decision to collapse or combine age categories due to small numbers is at the discretion of the Carnival Referee.
- Clarification of Rules & Regulations - For any technical rules and regulations queries, please first refer to the SLSA Surf Sports Manual (35th Revised Edition) for full details. This is available to download from the SLSA Members Portal. Please ensure you direct club members to their respective Surf Sports Manager before contacting State Centre.

Officials: Those clubs that have competitors participating in this year’s events MUST supply a minimum of ONE Official for every TEN (or part there) Competitors. The 1:10 ratio ensures adequate Officials are available to allow the event program to run to time and for multiple areas to be set up.

High Visibility Vests: All competitors **MUST** wear high visibility vests when competing. Please refer to the Page 18 of the [SLSA Personal Protective Equipment \(PPE\) Project Final Report – Surf Sports](#) for further information.

Trailers: Trailer access is from 7.30am. No trailers are permitted on the reserve. Trailers can be parked on grass area between railway lines and car parks.

Parking: Limited parking is available at the beach and please be aware of parking where meters exist. Parking is available at Multistory Carpark at Marine Terrace.

Club Tents: Tents only to be erected in designated areas set for visiting clubs. No pegs/ pickets are to be driven into the grass within 1 metre of the parameter of the grassed area under any circumstances due to a number of services (inc. electricity) run underneath the grass and could potentially cause death if damaged. **Please ensure you bring alternative methods to safely secure tents.**
