A reminder that each club is eligible to enter only ONE competitor per age group (M&amp;F). Each club will need to provide a patient if competing in the Champion Lifesaver event. See program below for specific Champion Lifesaver information.</p> <p><u>Medals</u> will be awarded throughout the day after blocks of events and a final presentation and announcement is scheduled to take place 1 hour after the final event</p> <p><u>Perpetual Trophies</u> will be awarded after the event, the following trophies will be presented:          Binni Wilson Shield (1 Male and 1 Female Competitor)          Tasmanian Surf Life Saving Championships – Point Score Winner          Tasmanian Surf Life Saving Championships – Handicap Point Score Winner</p> <p><u>U13 and U14 members</u> are eligible to contest the Under 15 age category once they have turned 13 and hold their Surf Rescue Certificate award.</p> <p><u>The combining of competitors</u> into event categories may be permitted in the case of insufficient competitors, or for other reasons to aid the conduct of the competition. The decision to collapse or combine age categories due to small numbers is at the discretion of the Carnival Referee.</p> <p><u>Clarification of Rules &amp; Regulations</u> - For any technical rules and regulations queries, please first refer to the SLSA Surf Sports Manual (35th Edition) for full details.
