Surf Boats Important Information

All surf boats will be need to be at the beach before 7.30am on Sunday 17th to access the beach prior to the start of the carnival. Boats will not be able to be removed from the beach until after the final event at the conclusion of the carnival.

Officials Numbers

Please refer to the below table to see the minimum number of officials each club must provide from the current entry numbers in order to achieve the 1:10 ratio.

Please note: For the program to run to time multiple areas will be required to run at the same time, in order to achieve this requires approximately 40+ Officials to be on the beach over the weekend so clubs are encouraged to supply more than the minimum 1:10.

For clubs with entrants in the Champion Lifesaver event please note that you will be required to provide an assessor and a patient for your competitor.

Late Entries

Normal entries have now closed and the paperwork prepared ahead of the weekend.

Late entries will need to be submitted in paper to either Toby Whitton (SLST VSO) or Liz Eustace (Carnival Recorder) prior to the first event on the morning of the carnival.

Officials please note late entries will not appear on marshalling/recording sheets and will need to be added manually. Late entries will incur an additional cost of \$11.50pp.
