



Application for National Patrol Service Awards

Overview

SLSA has established National Patrol Service Awards, which are available to individual members in recognition of their long service to surf lifesaving patrols.

Nomination Guidelines

Applications for SLSA National Patrol Service Awards are to be endorsed by the individual members affiliated club and submitted to Surf Life Saving Australia.

- This application may be lodged by either the member, or the member's current club. All details must be checked and endorsed by a designated senior club officer
- A **DUPLICATE** copy of the application form should be retained by the applicant or club and the **ORIGINAL** sent to SLSA
- Attach additional information if space is not sufficient
- The applicant's club must ensure that an **award request is lodged for each award in Surfguard (Form 14)** in order for the application to be processed successfully

It is not possible to accumulate ‘double years’ of patrol service by completing full patrols with a special service as well as club beach patrol in one year. The applicant must have completed all patrol service requirements relevant to the membership category with a minimum of 16 hours being completed per season.

Specific information on all other aspects of the National Patrol Service Awards, including the process of application, club verification of service and forwarding procedure should be directed through the respective State Centre.

Eligibility

Persons eligible for these awards are:-

- a) Bronze Medallion holders whose period of service eligibility begins from their initial patrol duties as the holder of this qualification.
- b) Members who hold one or more qualifications in the following award streams – patrolling lifesaver, emergency care or radio. In the case of Award members, eligibility for the patrol service award shall commence from the date of obtaining the relevant certificate.
