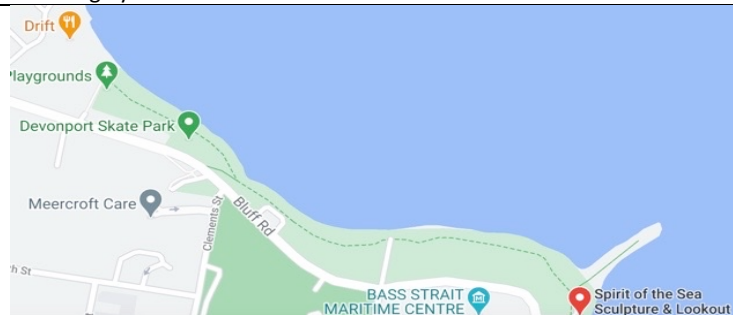

8 competitors per team

Under 15 to Masters

8 Teams

Each Competitor must do at least 3 events.

Each team picked by an appointed panel to promote fairness and inter-club camaraderie.

Relay Events

Board Relay

(2 person)

Each team may enter 2 teams of 2 competitors (2 x U15, 2 x Open)

Dry start, #1 team member paddles around 2 white cans (approx. 180m to cans), returns to shore, ditch craft in shallows and transition sprint (approx. 50m around black and white checkered flags), to tag #2 team member who paddles around white cans, returns to shore, ditch craft in shallows, sprint around 1 black and white checkered flag and finishes through 2 green and yellow flags / arch.

Ski Relay

(2 person)

Each team may enter 2 teams of 2 competitors.

Wet start, #1 team member paddles around 2 orange cans (approx. 250m to cans), returns to shore, ditch craft in shallows and transition sprint (approx. 50m around black and white checkered flags), to tag #2 team member who paddles around orange cans, returns to shore, ditch craft in shallows, sprint around 1 black and white checkered flag and finishes through 2 green and yellow flags.

Mixed Ocean Lifesaver Relay

(4 person)

Each team may enter 1 team consisting of 2 female and 2 male competitors.

Fixed race order of run, swim, board, ski.

55m transition sprint between leg each leg.

1st leg – Competitor #1 - 500m beach sprint to tag competitor #2

2nd leg - Competitor #2 wet start and swims 120m (2 red cans), returns to shore, 55m transition sprint around black and white flags and tags competitor #3

3rd leg – Competitor #3 wet start and paddles board 180m (2 white cans), returns to shore, 55m transition sprint around black and white flags and tags competitor #4

4th leg - Competitor #4 wet start and paddles ski 250m (3 orange cans), returns to shore, Ditch craft, turns around black and white checkered flag and dry finish between green and yellow flags/ arch.

Round 1 Burnie - Under 15 must contest first leg | Round 2 Clifton – Under 15 must contest first leg

Round 1 Burnie – Draw: Run, Swim, Board, Ski | Round 2 Clifton – Draw: Swim, Run, Board, Ski

All Age Wade Relay

(8 person)

As per Surf Sports Manual

Each team may enter 1 team of 8 persons

Under 15 competitors must contest 1st and 2nd leg of this event.

Individual / Team Events

Surf Swim Team

(2 person, 2 teams per team)

As per Surf Sports Manual

Points allocated to both swimmers according to finish placing

Results for both Under 15 and Open teams

Open teams will start first, Under 15 teams will commence race as leading Open competitors turn 2nd can and commence return to shore.

Board Team

(2 person, 2 teams per team)

As per Surf Sports Manual

Points allocated to both paddlers according to finish placing

Results for both Under 15 and Open teams

Open teams will start first, Under 15 teams will commence race as leading Open competitors turn 2nd can and commence return to shore.

Ski Team

(2 person)

As per Surf Sports Manual

Points allocated to both paddlers according to finish placing

Supplementary Notes:

- To comply with Surf Sports Manual guidelines, Under 15 competitors must not compete against any age group aside from their own.
- Contests for the TSTL will be modified to suit beach conditions and to reflect participation numbers.
- Running shoes are permitted and recommended for the 2k run.
