Registrations:	<p>All clubs are required to enter their competitors online using the: Sports Event Management System (SEMS)</p> <p>Entries for Tasmanian Junior Surf Lifesaving Championships close 09:00am Monday 22/02/2021</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><u>THERE WILL BE NO OPPORTUNITY FOR LATE ENTRIES.</u></p> <p>Please note Clubs, when doing Carnival entries, will be required to enter competitors in individual events only. If you have any questions regarding this, please direct them to Juppy (VSO) or ask Liz Eustace (Carnival Recorder) to talk you through how to do this at the Carnival.</p> <p>For team events there is a requirement to enter in SEMS the names of each competitors. This is required to make for simpler marshalling on the day. Reminder that you can change up to 50% of your team at marshalling if required.</p> <p>If you are responsible for entries for your club and you need help with this, please contact SLST VSO (sjupp@slst.asn.au). To enter via the Sports Event Management System (SEMS), go to https://sems.sls.com.au/#!login For the SLST SEMS Carnival Entry User Guide (2019), click to see the User Guide</p> <p>For access to SEMS for club Surf Sports Managers, contact: sjupp@slst.asn.au</p> <p>Please ensure that all Preliminary Evaluations, Competition Skills Evaluations and Annual Junior Awards have been completed and forwarded to SLST before attempting to enter competitors into SEMS.</p> <p>Clubs who have not completed their Surf Education Awards will not be able to use the Sports Event Management System to enter members who are still showing on Surfguard as not proficient.</p>
Water Safety:	To assist with the safety and efficiency of this year's event, clubs are encouraged to assist with the provision of Water Safety where possible. Contact Moira Black (0498 105 190) if able to assist.
High Visibility Vests:	All competitors MUST wear high visibility vests when competing. Please refer to the Page 18 of the SLSA Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) Project Final Report – Surf Sports for further information.
Competition Fees:	Competition fees for the Tasmanian Junior Championships will be \$15.50 per person (U8/9 – no medals) and \$30.50 per person (U10-14 – medals).
Venue Information:	Details of club events will be posted on the Carlton Park Facebook page and website.
Catering:	Breakfast available from 06:30 both Saturday and Sunday. Meals available Saturday night upstairs from 5.30pm Bar open Friday from 17:30 and Saturday / Sunday from 13:00
Car Parking:	Please allow extra time as parking close to the club may not be possible due to the large number competitors expected. Please be respectful to our neighbours and be mindful of blocking driveways in surrounding streets. Please keep Emergency Services access clear at ALL times.

Club Gear Trailers:	<p>Due to limited parking gear trailers can be dropped off at the eastern beach access gate behind the clubhouse for transport by CPSLSC vehicles onto the beach where they can be unpacked. Unfortunately tow vehicles will need to find separate parking locations.</p>
Traffic Delays:	<p>Expect some minor delays around the airport and Midway point due to major road works.</p> <p>Run the Bridge Fun Run Sunday only – the entire Tasman Bridge will be closed from 6.30am until 8.45am. Anyone wanting to come through from the western shore at that time will need to add 30 minutes to their trip and go via the Bowen Bridge. To allow for this the program on the Sunday will start at 09:30am.</p>
Supplementary Regulations:	<p>All events will be contested in accordance with the rules set out in the SLSA 36th Edition Surf Sports Manual, any subsequent SLSA Bulletins and SLST Local Rules that are distributed to Surf Sports Managers via Circulars from time to time.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Nil Supplementary Regulations noted for this event. <p>The SLSA Surf Sports Manual (36th Revised Edition) contains full competitive conditions rules and regulations. Other important event information:	<p><u>Medals</u> will be awarded throughout the day and a final presentation and announcement is scheduled to take place 1 hour after the final event. Please note: no medals will be awarded in the U8 and U9 age groups.</p> <p><u>Program Schedule</u> – Please note any events not started on Saturday due to weather conditions or time constraints may be held on Sunday.</p> <p><u>Perpetual Trophies</u> will be awarded at the conclusion of the event. The following trophies will be presented:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All Age Relay (U8-U14) (No individual medals will be awarded for this event) • Surf Life Saving Tasmania Junior Championships - Point Score Winner • Surf Life Saving Tasmania Junior Championships - Handicap Point Score Winner <p><u>Rules for a race</u> – Please refer Section 2 of the SLSA Surf Sports Manual (36th Revised Edition), General Competition Conditions, for full details of age specific rulings.</p> <p>The combining of competitors into event categories may be permitted in the case of insufficient competitors, or for other reasons to aid the conduct of the competition. The decision to collapse or combine age categories due to small numbers is at the discretion of the Carnival Referee.</p> <p><u>Clarification of Rules & Regulations</u> - For any technical rules and regulations queries, please first refer to the SLSA Surf Sports Manual (36th Revised Edition) for full details. This is available to download from the SLSA Members Area. Please ensure you direct club members to their respective Surf Sports Manager before contacting State Centre.</p> <p><u>Competition Liaison Officers:</u> The program has been designed to allow for competitor/s from a different age category to make up an incomplete team if required. A Competition Liaison Officer will be appointed to each Water Area to facilitate communications regarding team composition. Age Managers are</p>

to notify the Liaison Officer if they have a team issue (i.e., waiting on a competitor from another area) as soon as marshalling for the event is called. Failure to notify at the time of marshalling will result in no delay, no start.

Under 8 Foamie will not be run at the Junior Championships.

U8 age groups will not compete in a full Cameron (which includes a board leg). The Cameron for U8 age group will consist of 2 waders and 2 sprinters.

Sandshoes will be permitted in the 500m (U8 and U9) and 1km (U10/11/12/13/14) beach runs.
