If you have any questions regarding this, please direct them to Liz Eustace (Carnival Recorder) prior to entries closing. For team events there is a requirement to enter in SEMS the names of each competitor. This is required to make for simpler marshalling on the day. Water Safety:	To assist with the safety and efficiency of this year's event, clubs are encouraged to assist with the provision of Water Safety where possible. Contact Travis Dawe (0417 580 232) if able to assist.
High Visibility Vests:	All competitors MUST wear high visibility vests when competing. Please refer to the Page 18 of the SLSA Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) Project Final Report – Surf Sports for further information.
Competition Fees:	Competition fees for a Statewide Carnival will be \$15.50 per person.
Venue Information:	Details of club events will be posted on the Bridport SLSC Facebook page and website.
Catering:	Breakfast available from 06:30 both Saturday and Sunday. Meals available Saturday night from the food truck at the club from 17.00pm – please RSVP to secretary@bridportslsc.org.au if you intend to have dinner. Bar open Friday from 17:30 and Saturday from 16:00.
Car Parking:	Parking is available on the Bridport Village Green (see attached map). A sign and parking attendant will direct you to the parking. It is a short 100m walk to the club.
Club Tents:	In the interests of public safety all club tents are to be secured adequately for the duration of the carnival. Compliance will be checked prior to the start of event.
Club Gear Trailers:	Gear trailers can be parked within the Bridport SLSC compound adjacent to the beach (see attached map).
Camping:	Free camping is available on crown land adjacent to the Bridport SLSC. Please email secretary@bridportslsc.org.au to secure your camping spot. Club amenities can be used by campers throughout the weekend. Camping is only available for the nights of 7 th and 8 th January.

<p>Other important event information:</p>	<p><u>Program Schedule</u> – Please note all events and timings are subject to change at the discretion of the Carnival Referee.</p> <p><u>Rules for a race</u> – Please refer Section 2 of the SLSA Surf Sports Manual (36th Revised Edition), General Competition Conditions, for full details of age specific rulings.</p> <p>The combining of competitors into event categories may be permitted in the case of insufficient competitors, or for other reasons to aid the conduct of the competition. The decision to collapse or combine age categories due to small numbers is at the discretion of the Carnival Referee.</p> <p><u>Clarification of Rules & Regulations</u> - For any technical rules and regulations queries, please first refer to the SLSA Surf Sports Manual (36th Revised Edition) for full details. This is available to download from the SLSA Members Area. Please ensure you direct club members to their respective Surf Sports Manager before contacting State Centre.</p> <p><u>Competition Liaison Officers:</u> The program has been designed to allow for competitor/s from a different age category to make up an incomplete team if required. A Competition Liaison Officer will be appointed to facilitate communications regarding team composition. Age Managers are to notify the Liaison Officer if they have a team issue (i.e., waiting on a competitor from another area) as soon as marshalling for the event is called. Failure to notify at the time of marshalling will result in no delay, no start.</p> <p>U8 age groups will not compete in a full Cameron (which includes a board leg). The Cameron for U8 age group will consist of 2 waders and 2 sprinters.</p> <p>Sandshoes will be permitted in the 500m (U8 and U9) and 1km (U10/11/12/13/14) beach runs.</p>
