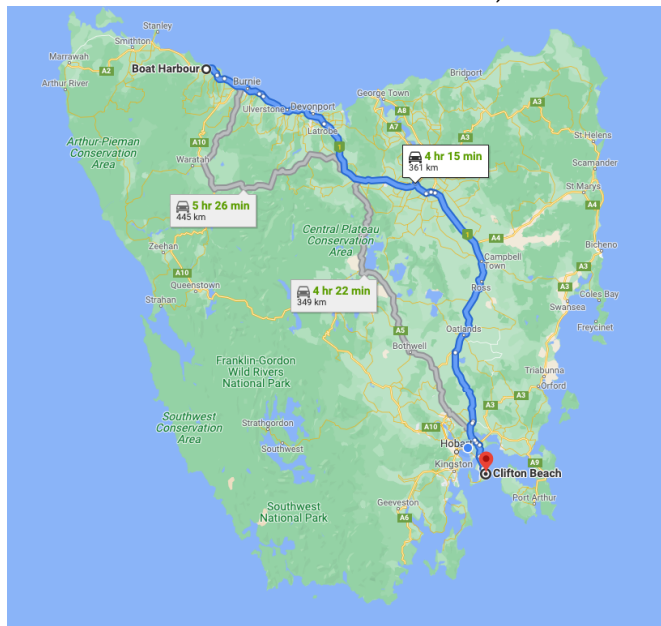

<u>Water Safety:</u>	<p>To assist with the safety and efficiency of this year's event, clubs are encouraged to assist with the provision of Water Safety where possible.</p> <p><b>Don't forget to log your Water Safety hours with host club as a visitor.</b></p> <p>Contact: Contact Ciaran McDonald (0408360103) if you are able to assist.</p>
<u>High Visibility Vests:</u>	<p>All competitors <b>MUST</b> wear high visibility vests when competing.</p>
<u>Competition Fees:</u>	<p>Competition fees for a Statewide Carnival will be \$15.50 per competitor, per day / event.</p>
<u>Venue Information:</u>	<p>Details of club events will be posted on the Clifton Beach SLSC Facebook page and website.</p>
<u>Catering:</u>	<p>Breakfast available from 07:00 both Saturday and Sunday.</p> <p>Meals available Saturday night.</p> <p>Bar open Friday from 17:30 and Saturday / Sunday from 13:00</p> <p>Updates or changes will be made via our Facebook page: Clifton Beach Surf Life Saving Club</p>

<p><u>Other important event information:</u></p>	<p><u>Program Schedule</u> – Please note all events and timings are subject to change at the discretion of the Carnival Referee.</p> <p><u>Rules for a race</u> – Please refer Section 2 of the SLSA Surf Sports Manual (37<sup>th</sup> Revised Edition), General Competition Conditions, for full details of age specific rulings. The combining of competitors into event categories may be permitted in the case of insufficient competitors, or for other reasons to aid the conduct of the competition. The decision to collapse or combine age categories due to small numbers is at the discretion of the Carnival Referee.</p> <p><u>Clarification of Rules &amp; Regulations</u> - For any technical rules and regulations queries, please first refer to the SLSA Surf Sports Manual (37th Revised Edition) for full details. This is available to download from the SLSA Members Area. Please ensure you direct club members to their respective Surf Sports Manager before contacting State Centre.</p> <p><u>Competition Liaison Officers:</u> The program has been designed to allow for competitor/s from a different age category to make up an incomplete team if required. A Competition Liaison Officer will be appointed to facilitate communications regarding team composition. Age Managers are to notify the Liaison Officer if they have a team issue (i.e., waiting on a competitor from another area) as soon as marshalling for the event is called. Failure to notify at the time of marshalling will result in no delay, no start.</p> <p>U8 age groups will not compete in a full Cameron (which includes a board leg). The Cameron for U8 age group will consist of 2 waders and 2 sprinters.</p> <p>Sandshoes will be permitted in the 500m (U8 and U9) and 1km (U10/11/12/13/14) beach runs.</p>
