

<b>SS Officials:</b>	<p>Those clubs that have competitors participating in this year’s events MUST supply a minimum of ONE SS Technical Official and then additional Officials (Core Official accredited and above) for every TEN (or part there) Competitors.</p> <p>The 1:10 ratio ensures adequate Officials are available to allow the event program to run to time and for multiple areas to be set up. SLST Carnival Officials Coordinator has already sought availabilities from all accredited officials and has commenced rostering key positions. <b>Registrations:</b>	<p>All clubs are required to enter their competitors online using the: Sports Event Management System (SEMS)  Entries for the Junior Statewide Carnival @ Burnie close:  <b>09:00am Tuesday 15/02/2022</b>  <b>THERE WILL BE NO OPPORTUNITY FOR LATE ENTRIES.</b></p> <p>Please note when doing Carnival entries, you will be required to enter competitors in individual and team events. If you have any questions regarding this, please direct them to Liz Eustace (Carnival Recorder) prior to entries closing. For team events there is a requirement to enter in SEMS the names of each competitor. This is required to make for simpler marshalling on the day. <p><b>Water Safety:</b></p>	<p>To assist with the safety and efficiency of this year’s event, clubs are encouraged to assist with the provision of Water Safety where possible. Contact <b>Geri Doherty 0400029503</b> if able to assist. <b>Don’t forget to log your Water Safety hours with host club as a visitor.</b></p>
<p><b>High Visibility Vests:</b></p>	<p>All competitors <b>MUST</b> wear high visibility vests when competing. Please refer to the Page 18 of the <a href="#">SLSA Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) Project Final Report – Surf Sports</a> for further information.</p>
<p><b>Competition Fees:</b></p>	<p>Competition fees for a Statewide Carnival will be \$15.50 per person.</p>
<p><b>Venue Information:</b></p>	<p>Details of club events will be posted on the Burnie SLSC Facebook page and website.</p>
	
<p><b>Catering:</b></p>	<p>Breakfast available from 09:00am Saturday. Food and Drinks available at the Club Canteen. Bar will be open mid-afternoon.</p>
<p><b>Car Parking:</b></p>	<p>Parking is available on North Terrace and nearby – Please see attached Map Please be aware that the car parking area surrounding the club is paid parking from: 9am – 2pm on Saturdays Download EasyPark App before arriving at the event. <a href="#">Burnie Council Parking Info link</a></p>
<p><b>Club Tents:</b></p>	<p>Tents can be set up on eastern and western side of the Burnie Surf Club and along the cement concourse. <b>No tent pegs are allowed as there are underground services close to the surface.</b> All clubs are asked to use sandbags and/or other weights to ground tents. In the interests of public safety all club tents are to be secured adequately for the duration of the carnival. Compliance will be checked prior to the start of event.</p>
<p><b>Club Gear Trailers:</b></p>	<p>Club Gear Trailers can be parked on grass area behind the club in front of paid parking. Vehicles are not allowed to be parked in this area.</p>
<p><b>Surf Boat Trailers:</b></p>	<p>No surf boats will be allowed access onto beach between timings to be confirmed. Please contact: <b>Hamish Howe 0419 253 908</b> for further assistance.</p>
<p><b>Supplementary Regulations:</b></p>	<p>All events will be contested in accordance with the rules set out in the SLSA 37<sup>th</sup> Edition Surf Sports Manual, any subsequent SLSA Bulletins and SLST Local Rules that are distributed to Surf Sports Managers via Circulars from time to time. Approved sanctioned events outside of the regulations of the Surf Sports Manual 37<sup>th</sup> Edition to be run at this event, include:</p>



	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <i>Under 8 Foamie and Under 10 Ironperson may be run if conditions permit. A final decision will be made by the carnival referee prior to the event. Note these events will not be run at the Junior State Championships.</i></li> <li>• <i>U8 age groups may not compete in a full Cameron (to include board leg. The Cameron for U8 age group may then consist of 2 waders and 2 sprinters.</i></li> <li>• <i>500m/1km beach run will be conducted if beach is available to conduct event. Sandshoes permitted and recommended.</i></li> <li>• <i>In team events, Male &amp; Female events will be run if possible.</i></li> <li>• <i>Mixed gender Teams will be recorded as a Male event.</i></li> </ul> <p>The SLSA Surf Sports Manual (37<sup>th</sup> Revised Edition) contains full competitive conditions rules and regulations. <p><b>Other important event information:</b></p>	<p><u>Program Schedule</u> – Please note all events and timings are subject to change at the discretion of the Carnival Referee.</p> <p><u>Rules for a race</u> – Please refer Section 2 of the SLSA Surf Sports Manual (37<sup>th</sup> Revised Edition), General Competition Conditions, for full details of age specific rulings.</p> <p>The combining of competitors into event categories may be permitted in the case of insufficient competitors, or for other reasons to aid the conduct of the competition. The decision to collapse or combine age categories due to small numbers is at the discretion of the Carnival Referee.</p> <p><u>Clarification of Rules &amp; Regulations</u> - For any technical rules and regulations queries, please first refer to the SLSA Surf Sports Manual (37<sup>th</sup> Revised Edition) for full details. This is available to download from the SLSA Members Area. Please ensure you direct club members to their respective Surf Sports Manager before contacting State Centre.</p> <p><u>Competition Liaison Officers:</u> The program has been designed to allow for competitor/s from a different age category to make up an incomplete team if required. A Competition Liaison Officer will be appointed to facilitate communications regarding team composition. Age Managers are to notify the Liaison Officer if they have a team issue (i.e., waiting on a competitor from another area) as soon as marshalling for the event is called. Failure to notify at the time of marshalling will result in no delay, no start.</p>
