Please note Clubs, when doing Carnival entries, will be required to enter competitors in individual events only. If you have any questions regarding this, please direct them to Juppy (VSO) or ask Liz Eustace (Carnival Recorder) to talk you through how to do this at the Carnival.			
For team events there is a requirement to enter in SEMS the names of each competitors. This is required to make for simpler marshalling on the day. Reminder that you can change up to 50% of your team at marshalling if required.

Please ensure that all Preliminary Evaluations, Competition Skills Evaluations and Annual Junior Awards have been completed and forwarded to SLST before attempting to enter competitors into SEMS.			
Clubs who have not completed their Surf Education Awards will not be able to use the Sports Event Management System (SEMS) to enter members who			
are stillshowing on Surfguard as not proficient.			
To assist with the safety and efficiency of this year's event, clubs are encouraged to assist with the provision of Water Safety where possible. Contact Allison Kable (0438 375 355) if able to assist.			
All competitors MUST wear high visibility vests when competing. Please refer to the Page 18 of the <u>SLSA Personal Protective Equipment (PPE)</u> <u>Project Final Report – Surf Sports</u> for further information.			
Competition fees for the Tasmanian Junior Championships will be \$15.50 per person (U8/9 – no medals) and \$30.50 per person (U10-14 – medals).			
Details of club events will be posted on the Penguin SLSC Facebook page. Due to the proximity of the railway system and ongoing works relating to the new Coastal Pathway, club safety team will be active to ensure all those attending are aware of any scheduled disruptions.			
Food is available from 08:00am both Saturday and Sunday. Meals available Friday night upstairs from 17.30pm			



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Car Parking:	Please allow extra time as parking close to the club may not be possible due to the large number competitors expected. Please be respectful to our neighbours and be mindful of blocking driveways around the bay and also pathway construction work. Please keep Emergency Services access clear at ALL times.
Club Gear Trailers:	Club trailers can be unloaded near beachaccess gate (map and further details will be provided before the event). Penguin work crew will be onsite to coordinate.
Club Tents:	In the interests of public safety all club tents are to be secured adequately for the duration of the carnival. Compliance will be checked prior to the start of event. A draw for club tent site allocation will be conducted prior to the event and published by email and social media.
Supplementary Regulations:	All events will be contested in accordance with the rules set out in the SLSA 37th Edition Surf Sports Manual, any subsequent SLSA Bulletins and SLST Local Rules that are distributed to Surf Sports Managers via Circulars from time to time. Approved sanctioned events outside of the regulations of the Surf Sports Manual 37th Edition to be run at this event, include: • U8 age groups may not compete in a full Cameron (to include board leg. The Cameron for U8 age group may then consist of 2 waders and 2 sprinters. • 500m/1km beach run will be conducted if beach is available to conduct event. Sandshoes permitted and recommended. • In team events, Male & Female events will be run if possible. • Mixed gender Teams will be recorded as a Male event. Rules for a race – Please refer Section 2 of the SLSA Surf Sports Manual (37th Edition), General Competition Conditions, for full details of age specificrulings. The combining of competitors into event categories may be permitted in the case of insufficient competitors, or for other reasons to aid the conduct of the competition. The decision to collapse or combine age categories due to small numbers is at the discretion of the Carnival Referee.

<u>Clarification of Rules & Regulations</u> - For any technical rules and regulations queries, please first refer to the SLSA Surf Sports Manual (37th Edition)for full details. This is available to download from the SLSA Members Area. Please ensure you direct club members to their respective Surf Sports Managerbefore contacting State Centre.

<u>Competition Liaison Officers</u>: The program has been designed to allow for competitor/s from a different age category to make up an incomplete team if required. A Competition Liaison Officer will be appointed to each Water Area to facilitate communications regarding team composition.

Age Managers are to notify the Liaison Officer if they have a team issue (i.e., waiting on acompetitor from another area) as soon as marshalling for the event is called. Failure to notify at the time of marshalling will result in no delay, no start.

Under 8 Foamie will not be run at the Junior Championships.

<u>U8 age groups</u> *will not* compete in a full Cameron (which includes a board leg).

The Cameron Relay for U8 age group will consist of 2 waders and 2 sprinters.

Sandshoes will be permitted in the 500m (U8 and U9) and 1km (U10/11/12/13/14) beach runs.
