Following completion of these steps is a practical assessment / acknowledgement of your skills as a Surf Sports Official.

This can be conducted at Statewide and Championship events by a Referee or our SSAC Officials Coordinator.

Following that your accreditation can be processed by SLST.

For those that assist on event days, there will be an attendance sheet at the morning briefing, pre event. All accredited Officials will be able to sign next to their name and all those that assist informally should add their name to the list and expect an invitation to complete the accreditation.

For our events to run well and improve, we require 1 Official for every 10 club competitors. All Officials are asked to indicate their availability to the Team Managers before entries close for athletes, as per the SLST Bulletins.

Holding this award is not only great for allowing your club to achieve maximum participation but it also provides you with the best view on the beach and an opportunity to build friendships with athletes and officials from around the state.

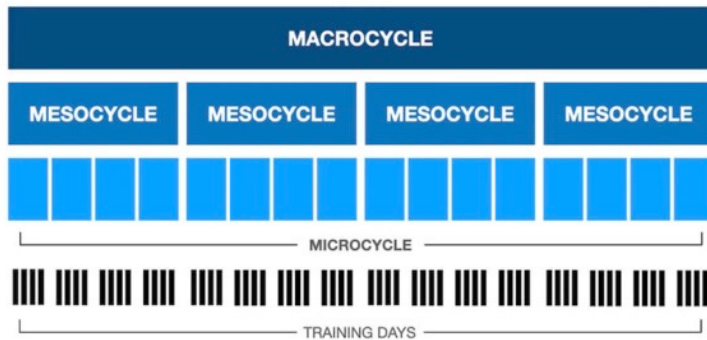
As part of the assessment, a SS Coach Assessor will wish to see evidence of long-term planning for athletes.

Whether that be daily / weekly (session plan), monthly (microcycle), quarterly (mesocycle) or annual (macrocycle).

Depending on your pre-determined outcomes.

There are many thoughts and variations of this model.
