During the program our Life Savers will present a one-hour session that will cover numerous topics on Aquatic Safety including the following:

- 🕒 Identify & avoid dangers
- 🕒 Who to go to for help
- 🕒 How to get out of trouble
- 🕒 How to assist others



Find the Red & Yellow Flags
What the red and yellow flags indicate and where to find them



Look for Safety Signs
Where to locate beach safety signs and interpret hazards



Ask a Lifesaver
Their role, how to identify one and how they can be of assistance



Go Swimming with an Adult
Emphasising the importance of never swimming alone



Signal for Help
How to attract attention, stay calm and get yourself or others out of danger



Surf Life Savers will explain keywater safety concepts to students, as detailed in the infographics.



The presenters will tailor the information to the school's surrounding areas.

e.g. swimming in dams, rivers, or lakes.



Students will receive Beach to Bush activity sheets to help them reflect on and share their knowledge.
