Summary:	Expressions of Interest are now open for members aged 13-15 years who wish to attend the 2025 Junior Lifesaver Camp. This circular outlines the Expression of Interest process and next steps.

CIRCULAR DETAILS

Overview

The Junior Lifesaver Camp (JLC) is for members aged 13 to 15. The three-day live-in program has been designed to support those members who have completed Nippers and are looking for their path in Surf Life Saving. JLC aims to assist in this process and showcase the various development and leadership pathways available.

To encourage teamwork and foster camaraderie among the participants, the camp will incorporate team challenges and group activities. Lifesaving scenarios will be simulated, allowing the young members to work together in a coordinated manner, practice communication skills, and develop a strong sense of trust and reliance on their fellow teammates.

The Junior Lifesaver Camp will not only enhance the participants' existing skills but will also provide them with opportunities for personal growth and self-confidence. Guest speakers, including experienced youth and successful lifesavers, will share their inspiring stories and insights, motivating the young members to aim higher and excel in their lifesaving journey as well as their life outside of lifesaving.

As a person attending this camp and representing your Club / Unit, candidates will always act according to SLSA and SLST's policies and procedures, including the Code of Conduct.

- Current financial members of a SLST affiliated organisation (Club / VMR).
- Members aged between 13 & 15.

Expression of Interest and Registration Process

All interested applicants aged between 13 and 15 years are encouraged to apply.

Once all expressions of interest have been received by Monday 28 July 2025 they will be reviewed. Endorsement by a club representative (for example, Club President, Junior Activities Coordinator, Lifesaving Manager) is required and will be sought at this stage.

It is hoped that all interested members can attend, however numbers will be capped due to accommodation and camp logistics. In consultation with the clubs, priority will be given to candidates ensuring there is representation from across the state, and to the older members, as the 13-year-olds will have another opportunity to attend JLC next year.

All applicants will be notified directly as to whether they have been offered a spot. Successful applicants will be sent a registration form to complete to ensure we have all the right information to create a safe and fun environment at Camp Clayton. Unsuccessful applicants will be placed on a waitlist in the event a spot becomes available. To discuss this further, please contact us (details below).
