



AWARD CRITERIA & NOMINATION FORM

SLST HALL OF FAME

BACKGROUND

The Surf Life Saving Tasmania (SLST) Hall of Fame is an integral part of recognising the achievements and efforts of members in the Tasmanian Surf Lifesaving movement.

The Hall of Fame permanently displays, commemorates and recognises members and teams who have achieved outstanding accomplishments and exceptional contributions to the development of surf lifesaving in Tasmania. The achievements are not restricted in relation to the area of their contribution but must have been inspirational in application to surf lifesaving activities and have been separated into categories explained below in the criteria section.

Essential Criteria

The following criteria will be taken into consideration of each nomination.

Nominations must clearly demonstrate that individuals or teams have:

- (i) Displayed exceptional service to surf lifesaving in the specific category.
- (ii) Achieved outstanding individual or team accomplishments which sets the individual or team apart from other lifesavers or teams.
- (iii) Displayed sustained excellence over a long period of time to the category for which they are nominated.

CATEGORIES

Each award is allocated under the following categories:

- a) Lifesaving
- b) Surf Life Saving Administration
- c) Surf Sport
- d) A combination of any of the above

Lifesaving

This category recognises those who have been involved in all facets of surf lifesaving operations. Examples are active patrolling, training and examination, rescue services and the general support activities involved in beach patrols, search and rescue, and surveillance.

Minimum Selection Criteria

- a. Key lifesaving development role within SLST where the individual has displayed exceptional services and demonstrated significant contribution to the development and sustainability of lifesaving at state level.
- b. Key roles for significant periods in developing lifesaving within SLST.



Surf Life Saving Administration

This category recognises those involved in the purely administrative aspects of surf lifesaving. Examples are, but not limited to, club secretaries and treasurers. This category also includes surf sports officials.

Minimum Selection Criteria

- a. Key SLST roles where the individual has displayed exceptional service and demonstrated significant contribution to the development and sustainability of SLST
- b. Key roles in the establishment and implementation of SLST initiatives which benefit lifesaving statewide
- c. Members that have given their time to leadership roles in the areas of development, lifesaving or sport which have benefited all members at a state level.

Surf Sport

This category recognises those who have excelled in lifesaving sports and/or the coaching and training associated with lifesaving sports.

Minimum criteria

- a. Recognises the states most outstanding athletes who achieve exceptional sporting achievements and sustainable excellence in the surf sports arena at a state, national and or international level.
- b. Recognises coaches/trainers who have made a significant and sustainable contribution towards an athlete's development and performance at a state and or national level.

APPLICATION ELIGIBILITY

Only current or past individual members of SLST are eligible for induction into the Tasmanian Surf Life Saving Hall of Fame (Note: that nominations may be for eligible individual members or for teams of eligible members).

Nominations not endorsed may only be re-submitted for consideration after a period of two (2) years. Nominations being re-submitted should be enhanced in order to meet the standard of the award.

CRITERIA

The following criteria are to be addressed in each nomination:

- a. Nominations may be for one category; however, evidence supporting the nomination covering activities relevant to the other categories should be provided and will be taken into consideration. It is important that the complete career of the nominee is put forward to allow a total assessment.
- b. Nominees are to be in good standing with SLST. Controversy should be avoided. Persons charged with using performance-enhancing drugs, for example, or who have been found guilty of criminal offences (whether connected with SLST or not) should not be nominated.



d. Nominations should draw names from a broad range of members or teams who have been or are currently:

- Office holders and administrators
- Patrolling members
- Rescue service groups
- Assessors
- Competitors
- Competitive Teams
- Competition Officials
- Coaches
- Advisors (eg: medical)

NUMBER OF NOMINEES

Nominations for the SLST Hall of Fame will only be considered once each year and there is no limit to the number of nominees inducted into the hall of fame each year. SLST recognises the prestigious nature of this award and will consider applications appropriately.

WHO CAN NOMINATE

Nominations to the Hall of Fame may only be made by:

- Affiliated clubs
- Directors of SLST

The nominations **MUST** be completed on the appropriate form and are to be endorsed by the nominees' club or an SLST Director. All nominations are to be forwarded to the SLST General Manager from the appropriate club or Director of SLST

Nominations must be accompanied by a photo of sufficient quality for scanning and a conclusive history covering the service and outstanding or pioneering achievements to SLST which address the criteria. The accompanying history is restricted to two pages for each nominee.

ASSESSMENT AND NOTIFICATION PROCEDURE

Assessment will be conducted by an appointed SLST committee, chaired by the SLST President. The President of SLST will submit the nominations together with the recommendations from the committee to the SLST Board for decision. Only the President of SLST or a person authorised by him, shall recommend to the SLST Board eligible persons and or teams to be recognised for this award.

Assessment will be conducted under the criteria as outlined above. The decision of the SLST Board will be final.

All successful nominees will be advised in writing of their endorsement by the SLST Board and induction arrangements into the Hall of fame.



TIMING AND PRESENTATION

Induction into the SLST Hall of Fame takes place annually at the Awards of Excellence at an appropriate date, time and location to be determined by SLST each year.
