Summary:	The circular details the nomination process for SLST Life Membership and the Hall of Fame.

Nominations are now being accepted for SLST Life Membership and the SLST Hall of Fame.

SLST Life Membership

Do you know a member who has provided distinguished service to Surf Life Saving Tasmania (SLST) at State level for 20 years or more? If so, they may be eligible for Life Membership recognition.

All nominations will be forwarded to the Meritorious and Awards Committee for consideration and then to the State Council for endorsement at the SLST Annual General Meeting (AGM) in October.

Successful recipients will be presented with their Life Membership at an occasion deemed appropriate by the SLST Board of Directors, with recipients advised accordingly.

'Life membership is awarded to members who have rendered distinguished voluntary service to Surf Life Saving Tasmania at State level for over a period of at least 20 years. To be considered as distinguished service, the service must be both sustained and provide a conspicuous contribution.'

Life Membership of a nominee's club does not automatically entitle a nominee to Life Membership of SLST, although it may be considered when assessing a nomination.

Life Membership is awarded in accordance with SLST Constitution Section 5.3 and SLST Regulations Section 1.5.

SLST Hall of Fame

Nominations are also being accepted for the SLST Hall of Fame. Please refer to the attached selection criteria and nomination form for more details.

The Surf Life Saving Tasmania (SLST) Hall of Fame is an integral part of recognising the achievements and efforts of members in the Tasmanian Surf Life Saving movement

The Hall of Fame permanently displays, commemorates and recognises members and teams who have achieved outstanding accomplishments and exceptional contributions to the development of surf lifesaving in Tasmania in the categories of:

- a) Surf lifesaving
- b) Surf Lifesaving –Leadership/Administration
- c) Surf Lifesaving - Sport
- d) A combination of any of the above

The achievements are not restricted in relation to the area of their contribution but must have been inspirational in application to surf lifesaving activities and have been separated into categories explained in the criteria section.

Successful applicants will be inducted into the SLST Hall of Fame at an occasion deemed appropriate by the SLST Board of Directors, with inductees notified accordingly.
