LIFE MEMBERSHIP OF SURF LIFE SAVING TASMANIA

Life membership is awarded to members who have rendered distinguished voluntary service to Surf Life Saving Tasmania at a State level for over a period of at least 20 years. To be considered as distinguished service, the service must be both sustained and provide a conspicuous contribution. Life Membership is awarded in accordance with SLST Constitution Section 5.3 and SLST Regulations Section 1.5.

PRIVACY

These personal details are being collected by Surf Life Saving Tasmania for the purpose of assessing the nominee's eligibility for Life Membership of SLST. The personal information will be disclosed to the SLST Life Members & Honours Committee & State Council for the same purpose. These details will not be disclosed to any third parties by Surf Life Saving Tasmania. You have the right to access the information held about you by Surf Life Saving Tasmania.

Essential Selection Criteria:

- a) A nominee must have provided outstanding volunteer service to SLST, demonstrated by the following:
 - i. a sustained level of conspicuous service at a level that brings distinction to that service. The point of distinction to this recognition is the distinguished nature of their contribution over a period of at least 20 years that sets them apart from other significant service by other members;
 - ii. an individual contribution that can be classified as unique, and which can be attributed to that person as opposed to being a member of a wider group of members;
 - iii. a significant contribution to the advancement of SLST.

A nominee must be able to demonstrate having acted in the following areas:

- i. Governance (for example State Advisory Committee, Specialist Committee, the SLST Board).
- ii. Lifesaving (for example, Assessor/Examiner, patrol inspection, support operations).
- ii. Education and training (for example Assessor/Examiner and Instructor training,

Official's and Coaching accreditation).

iii. Surf Sports: (for example, Referee, Competition Official, SLST State Coach/Manager, Water Safety) and

iv. Nippers and Youth (for example Development Camp Leaders, Nipper Referee).

A nominee does not need to demonstrate having acted in every essential criterion as described above for the required period provided that the minimum overall period is met.
